

Personal Goods brought to School at Owners Risk

Rationale:

This policy has been made to ensure schools advise the school community about the Department's policy on private property.

Personal property is often brought to school by staff, students and visitors. This can include mobile phones, electronic games, calculators, toys, musical instruments, sporting equipment, and cars parked on school premises.

Principals

Principals must inform staff/parents/guardians and students at enrolment, and remind them annually:

- that private property brought to school by students is not insured by the school or covered by school insurance, and that it is not the responsibility of the Department if that property is lost, stolen or damaged.
- the department does not hold insurance for personal good brought to school and it has no capacity to pay for any loss or damage to such property.
