BLUE Spelling Mastery Rules

<p>/e/ spelled e-e When you hear the long /e/ sound in words it is usually spelled 'ee' as in keep and sleep</p>	<p>Long i in the middle of words When you hear the long i in the middle of a word it is usually spelled 'igh' as in tight and bright.</p>	<p>Is it a y or igh for the long i sound? If the word finishes in the long i sound and there is a consonant directly before it, the word will end in y as in fly, sky</p>	<p>When I hear 'ape' how is it spelled? All words that end with 'ape' are spelled like ape as in cape, grape and scrape.</p>	<p>/a/ spelled a-y at the end of a word If you hear the long a sound at the end of the word it is 'ay' as in tray and spray</p>	<p>The sound /or/ in words If you hear the sound /or/ in words it is usually spelled 'or' as in sport, fort and porch</p>	<p>What makes the /oo/ sound in words? If you hear the /oo/ sound in the middle of a word, it is normally spelled with the letters o-o as in mood, scoop and boot</p>
<p>Do I need a 'ck' or a 'k'? If you hear /ack/, /eck/, /ick/, /ock/ or /uck/ in a word it is 'ck' at the end as in sock, cluck. Otherwise it is a k as in soak, cheek</p>	<p>Do I need 'ge or 'dge'? If you hear /adge/, /edge/, /idge/, /odge/ or /udge/, the ending of the word is 'dge' as in wedge, judge. Otherwise it is 'ge' as in wage, plunge.</p>	<p>/uff/ spelled 'ough' When you hear the sound /uff/ in words it is spelled with 'ough' as in enough, tough and rough</p>	<p>/ood/ spelled 'ould' When you hear the /ood/ sound, like in should it is normally spelled the same way as in could and would</p>	<p>/ss/ at the end of words? This is the same rule as 'dge' and ck. If you hear ass, ess, iss, oss or uss it is spelled s-s as in fuss, mess, hiss.</p>	<p>/ss/ at the end of words spelled 'ce' Any words that end with the /ss/ sound at the end of a word and they dont fit the previous rule, the /ss/ is represented with 'ce' as in fence and voice</p>	<p>Long a-s sounds in words When you hear a long a-s sound in words it is spelled 'ace' as in face and space</p>
<p>Morphographic rule All morphographs in a word have meaning. In the word rebuild there are two morphographs and each has a meaning. Re = again, so in rebuild it means to build again.</p>	<p>Hear the long /a/, /i/ or /o/ When you hear the long a, long i or long o in a word it is spelled with an e at the end of the word as in wake, like, smoke.</p>	<p>Do i need 'ch' or 'tch' at the end of the word? If the ending in a word is -atch, -etch, -itch or -otch the last part of the word is spelled -tch as in catch and stitch. Otherwise it is a ch as in attach and beach</p>	<p>/rr/spelled 'wr' at the beginning of a word If you hear the /rr/ sound at the beginning of a word it is spelled with a 'wr' as in wrist and wrong</p>	<p>Long e spelled y at the end of words If you hear the long /e/ sound at the end of a word it is spelled with a 'y' as in study, carry and busy</p>	<p>Do I need the 'e' when I add a morphograph to the end of a word? If the final morphograph begins with a vowel then drop the e as in hope / ing = hoping. Otherwise you keep the 'e' as in hope / ful = hopeful.</p>	<p>Short CVC words A word of four or less letters with the last three letters as consonant / vowel / consonant is classified as a short CVC word as in step, crab and cat</p>

<p>Doubling rule in short cvc words When you add a morphograph to the end of a short cvc word that starts with a vowel the final consonant is doubled as in star + ing = starring and skip + ing = skipping</p>	<p>Y as a vowel letter If 'y' is at the end of a morphograph then it makes the sound of a vowel as in happy and berry</p>	<p>Word forms Changing the final morphograph of a word can make a different form of a word as in Rest Rested Restless Restful are all forms of the word rest</p>				
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
